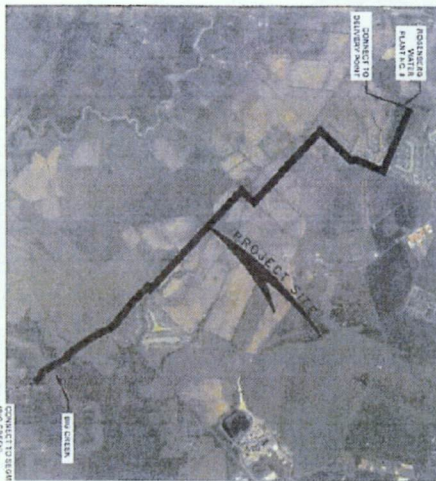

1. Flagg depicted to signs where shown are REQUIRED, except those with a "D" in the upper right corner.
2. All required control devices illustrated are REQUIRED, except those in the plans, or for routine and maintenance work, when approved by the Engineer.
3. Inoperative work vehicles or other equipment should be posted near the work.
4. A vehicle with a "D" in the upper right corner should be positioned on the right side of the road, not farther than 30 to 100 feet in advance of the area of work, appears without covering the performance or quality of the work. If workers are in the center of the road, the vehicle should be positioned in the center of the lane.
5. Additional Stop Signs with "D" may be positioned at the entrance to the work area, and at the exit, to control the flow of traffic.
6. The "D" in the upper right corner should be positioned at the entrance to the work area, and at the exit, to control the flow of traffic.
7. "ROAD WORK AHEAD" signs for shoulder work on conventional roadways.

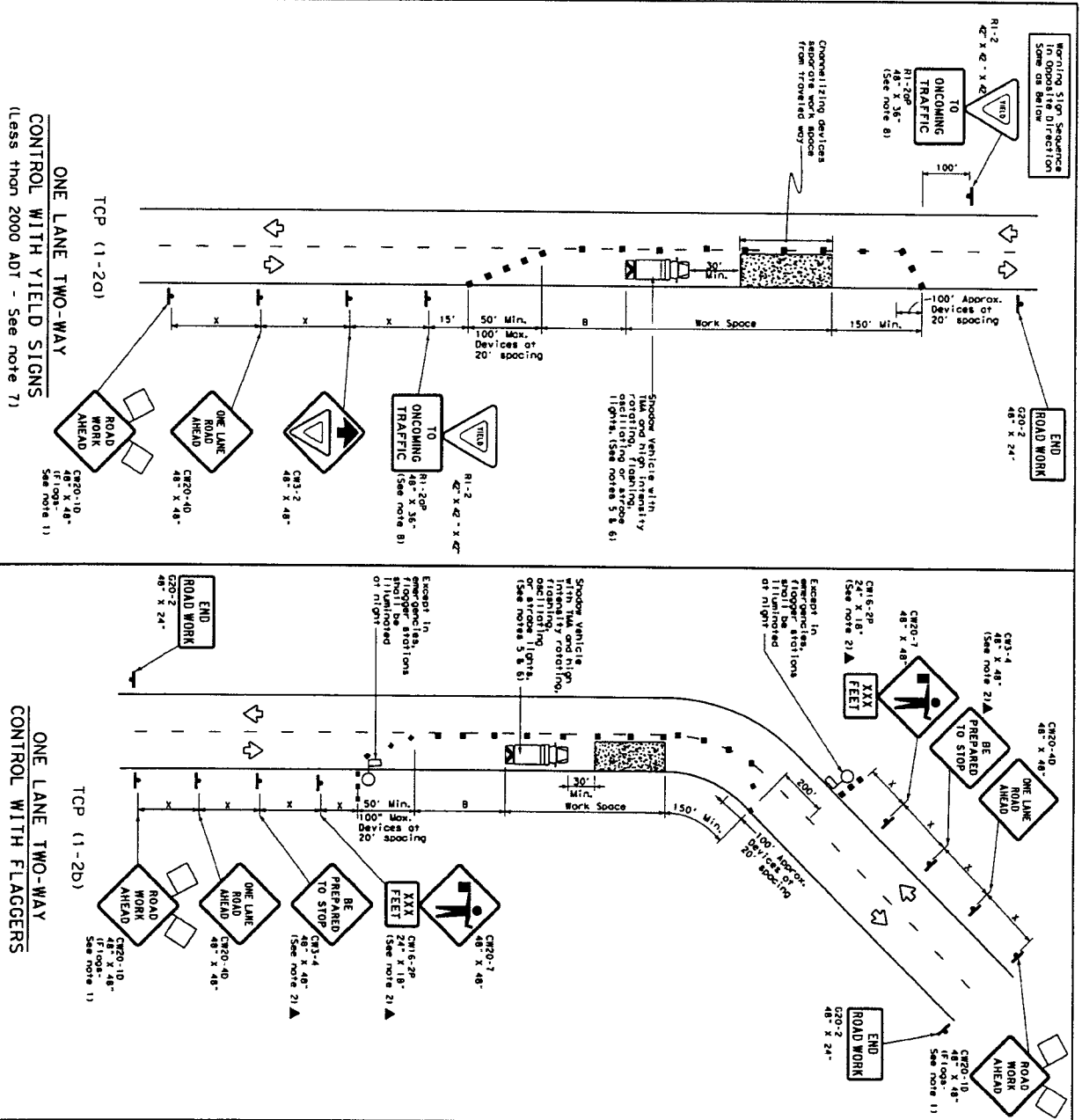
TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN CONVENTIONAL ROAD SHOULDER WORK

GENERAL NOTES

1. Flaps attached to signs where areas are REQUIRED.
 2. All traffic control devices illustrated or REQUIRED, except those devoted with the following speed may be utilized when stored elsewhere in the plant, or for routine maintenance.
 3. The "BE REFLECTED TO STOP" sign may be handled after the DCTO-40D LANE ROAD AHEAD sign, but proper alignment spacing shall be maintained.
 4. Stop spacing may be increased or an additional C20-10D ROAD WORK AHEAD sign may be used if adverse weather caused the stopper or R2-7EIELD sign is less than 1500 feet from the stopper.
 5. In absence of the area of work exposure without adversely affecting the performance quality of the work, if vehicles are no longer present but road or work conditions require the traffic control to remain in place, Type 3 bar/blocks or other channelizing devices may be substituted for the Stopper vehicle and TMA.
 6. Those signs in order to protect wider work spaces.
- TCP (I-20)
1. R1-2EIELD sign traffic control may be used on projects with open-cuttings that have more than half city block, in solid concrete or masonry walls less than 2800 sq ft, work spaces should be no longer than 400 feet.
 2. R1-2EIELD sign with R1-2G-10D ONCOMING TRAFFIC plaque should be placed on a support or a 7 foot aluminum mounting height.
 3. Plaque should use two-way rodlets or other methods of communication to control traffic.
 4. Length of work space should be based on the ability of flagger to communicate.
 5. If the work space is located near a horizontal or vertical curve, the buffer distance should be increased in order to maintain adequate stopping sight distance to the stopper.
 6. Channelizing devices on the centerline may be omitted when a pilot or its feeding traffic and approved by the Engineer.
 7. Flagger should use 24" D10V-20M paddles to control traffic. Flaggers should be alerted to emergency situations.

For construction or maintenance contract work, specific project requirements for shoddy vehicles can be found in the project GENERAL NOTES for Item 502, Barriercodes, Signs and Traffic Handling.

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
