
ORDER AUTHORIZING LITIGATION

On this 28th day of November, 2017, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, being convened at a regular meeting of the Court, sitting as the governing body of Fort Bend County, upon motion of Commissioner Morales, seconded by Commissioner Meyers, duly put and carried, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The Fort Bend County Attorney's Office is hereby authorized to file a lawsuit on behalf of Fort Bend County, Texas and/or the State of Texas against Allen Paksima for any and all monetary damages caused to Fort Bend County, Texas and/or the State of Texas, for any and all civil penalties payable to and/or enforceable by Fort Bend County, Texas or the State of Texas. Fort Bend County is the lawful owner a validly existing right-of-way easement, beginning at the point where the centerline of ditch II-FF intersects the West boundary line of Mr. Paksima's 74.892 acre tract of land and continues downstream along various meanders of the centerline to the point of intersection with the centerline of ditch II-E-1-a. Fort Bend County's ownership of this easement is for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating and repairing a drainage canal of which Mr. Paksima has restricted access.

The County Attorney's Office is hereby authorized to seek the full measure of monetary damages and all recoverable elements thereof, as well as any other appropriate legal and equitable relief, including but not limited to actual damages, consequential damages, additional damages, statutory damages and penalties, exemplary damages and/or punitive damages, attorney's fees, litigation expenses, pre-judgment interest, court costs, interest on the judgment, collection costs, temporary and permanent injunctive, declaratory, or equitable relief, and other relief to which the County may be entitled.
