Commissioner Meyers gave an update on the Rail District and the Port. The Port has reported they have received approval from the U.S. Corps of Engineers for preliminary engineering design to deepen the channel and dockside as well as to improve expanding the port to accommodate larger ships. They anticipate construction will begin in 2020. The Port indicated they have had numerous inquiries from operators, shipping lines and container operators with regard to begin negotiating with the Port. The Rail District has made applications to TXDOT Rail District for a \$600,000 grant to fund a study. The Chairman of the District has indicated they anticipate taking action during their next meeting to engage a Project Manager/Administrative Manager of the Rail District to handle day to day operations and for an Administrator of the TXDOT grant. In addition, the current leadership has served two years and the Rail District will be rotating the Chairmanship as well as the other officers of the Rail District.

Judge Hebert indicated the \$50,000 being voted on today is the third installment of three the Court discussed when the original funding was made. He also indicated he will meet with Port Freeport Authorities and the County Judge of Brazoria County to discuss objectives they will have to meet in the coming year in order to maintain his support for the activities of the Rail Authority.
