5. **Take all appropriate action on adoption of Local Option Exemptions for the Fort Bend County Drainage District property taxes for the 2018 Tax Year as follows, pursuant to Section 11.13(n) of the Texas Property Tax Code:**

- **Homestead Exemption: \$5,000 or 20 percent (whichever is greater); and**
- **Over 65 Exemption: \$100,000; or**
- **Disabled Person Exemption: \$100,000.**

Moved by Commissioner Meyers, Seconded by Commissioner Morales Duly put and unanimously carried (5-0), it is ordered to adopt Local Option Exemptions for the Fort Bend County Drainage District property taxes for the 2018 Tax Year as follows, pursuant to Section 11.13(n) of the Texas Property Tax Code:

- Homestead Exemption: \$5,000 or 20 percent (whichever is greater); and
- Over 65 Exemption: \$100,000; or
- Disabled Person Exemption: \$100,000.

Judge Hebert pointed out the 20% and \$100,000 exemptions are the maximum amounts set by state law.

Commissioner Patterson emphasized that someone who is 65 and over can apply for exemptions online.
