- FORT BEND COUNTY SPECIFICATIONS**
1. NO MORE TRENCH DEPTH AT ONE TIME THAN CAN BE BACKFILLED AND COMPACTED IN ONE DAY. ALL TRENCHES SHALL BE BACKFILLED AND COMPACTED IN ONE DAY. (SEE SECTION 01100 AND TRENCH LEFT OPEN DURING DAY)
 2. ALL EXCESS EXCAVATION TO BE REMOVED FROM ROAD RIGHT OF WAY AT THE END OF EACH WORK DAY
 3. DITCHES TO BE OPENED AT END OF EACH DAY TO ASSURE ADEQUATE DRAINAGE.
 4. ROAD MUST BE KEPT OPEN TO TRAFFIC AND CONSTRUCTION MUST PROVIDE ADEQUATE PROTECTION TO TRAFFIC AND PROVIDE COMPLETE SAFETY TO THE PUBLIC.
 5. IF IT BECOMES NECESSARY FOR EQUIPMENT TO OPERATE ON A PORTION OF THE PAVEMENT, PRECAUTIONS SHOULD BE TAKEN TO PREVENT ANY DAMAGE WHATSOEVER TO THE PAVEMENT. CONDITION OF ROAD UPON COMPLETION OF JOB TO BE SAME AS GOOD OR BETTER THAN PRIOR TO STARTING.
 6. ROW DEPTH TO TOP OF CURB OR CONDUIT SHALL BE MAINTAINED TO A MINIMUM OF 36" BELOW ANY ROADSIDE DITCH.
