**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR
 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

THIS AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and HTS, Inc. Consultants, (hereinafter "Contractor"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Services on October 10, 2017, (hereinafter "Agreement") pursuant to SOQ 14-025; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement for additional services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation for the completion of such additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. County shall pay Contractor an additional twenty-five thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$25,000.00), to additional construction materials testing and inspection services as described in Contractor's Cost Estimate Addendum dated April 17, 2018 attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed sixty-four thousand six hundred twenty-four dollars and 55/100 (\$64,624.55), authorized as follows:
 - \$39,624.55 under the Agreement; and
 - \$25,000.00 under this Amendment.
3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and this Amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without written agreement executed by both parties.
4. Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts
 - a. Agreement to Not Boycott Israel Chapter 2270 Texas Government Code: By signature below, Contractor verifies Contractor does not boycott Israel and will not boycott Israel during the term of this Agreement.

1.0 INTRODUCTION
