Dear Mr. Gardovsky:

This letter shall confirm the requirements regarding provisions by the <u>Riverstone Homeowner's Association (Riverstone HOA)</u> to maintain the private streets in the above referenced subdivision in perpetuity.

Pursuant to the Fort Bend County Regulations of Subdivisions, as amended, and the approved plat, the above referenced subdivision assesses and collects an assessment from all property owners. The revenue generated from the assessment is used to cover specific operating expenses of the subdivision, as well as capital reserve expenses such as maintenance of private streets.

The governing documents of the <u>Riverstone Homeowner's Association (Riverstone HOA)</u>, more specifically the Declaration of Covenants, or similar document, grant the authority to the subdivision to levy and collect these assessments and legally obligate each property owner to pay said assessment each year.

Each year, the assessments are placed in a Capital Reserve account. Monies from the Capital Reserve account will be used for repair of the private streets in <u>Avalon at Riverstone Section Twelve-A</u> (name of subdivision), as well as other items as approved by the Board of Directors of the HOA.

Should you require more specific documentation regarding <u>Avalon at Riverstone Section Twelve-A</u> (name of subdivision) provisions to provide for maintenance of the private streets, please advise me of that. Otherwise, I shall assume this letter satisfies the documentation request. If this is satisfactory then arrangements can be made for the County to inspect these streets and <u>Jaho</u>, <u>Inc./Taylor Morrison of Texas</u> (Contractor/Developer's name), may request the release of their bond or letter of credit.
