

CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN A PERMIT FROM FORT BEND COUNTY PERMIT ADMINISTRATOR (281) 533-7500, PRIOR TO ANY WORK WITHIN THE FORT BEND COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT SEABOURNE CREEK RIGHT-OF-WAY.





### GENERAL

- 1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY EXISTING CONDITIONS BEFORE BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING SECURITY TO PROTECT THE PROJECT SITE. INTRACTOR PROPERTY, EQUIPMENT, AND WORK
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING STREETS OF CONSTRUCTION DIRT AND DEBRIS AT CLOSE OF EACH WORK DAY.
- 4. THE CONDITION OF THE ROAD AND/OR RICHT-OF-WAY, UPON COMPLETION OF THE JOB SHALL BE AS GOOD AS OR BETTER THAN PRIOR TO STARTING WORK.

  2. ALL MANHOLES ARE TO BE PER CITY OF ROSENBERG STANDARD DETAILS DRAWING UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR, ALONG WITH CONCURRENCE FROM THE FIELD ENGINEER, SHALL DETERMINE HIS/HER LAY-DOWN AND/OR STAGING AREA LOCATIONS.
- 6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY ALL PROPERTY OWNERS A MINIMUM OF 24 HOURS PRIOR TO BLOCKING 4. DRIVEWAYS OR ENTERING UTILITY EASEMENTS.
- 7. TRAFFIC INGRESS AND EGRESS FOR DRIVEWAYS AND PEDESTRIAN ACCESS FACILITIES SHALL BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT CONSTRUCTION UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE CITY ENGINEER.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE ANY FENCES, POSTS, PLANTERS, PERMANENT TRASH CONTAINERS, CULVERTS, ETC. OR SECTIONS THEREOF, THAT ENCROACH WITHIN THE CITY'S RIGHT-OF-WAY. NOTE-PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, THE PROPERTY OWNER WAS PAID TO RELOCATE OR REPLACE THESE ITEMS OUTSIDE OF THE CITY'S RIGHT-OF-WAY.
  - IF THE OWNER HAS FAILED TO DO SO, THE CONTRACTOR WILL REPLACE THEM WITH THE MINIMUM LEVEL 7. OF QUALITY NEEDED TO SECURE THE PROPERTY. IN THAT CASE, PAYMENT FOR THESE INSTALLATIONS WILL BE INCLUDED AS EXTRA WORK ITEMS OR AS OVERRINNS TO EXISTING PAY TEMS.
  - ANY DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO SUCH ITEMS LOCATED OUTSIDE OF THE CITY'S RIGHT-OF-WAY, SHALL BE REPLACED WITH LIKE-KIND OR BETTER AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
  - ALSO, IF THESE ITEMS ARE LOCATED WITHIN THE PROJECT RIGHT-OF-WAY AND ARE DESIGNATED TO REMAIN, ANY DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE CONTRACTOR TO SUCH ITEMS, SHALL BE REPLACED WITH LIKE-CHINO OR BETTER AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
  - THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING MAILBOXES TO TEMPORARY LOCATIONS WHERE DELIVERY SERVICES CAN BE MAINTAINED. AND MOVING TO FINAL LOCATIONS BY COMPLETION OF
  - REMOVAL OF TREES, BUSHES, SHRUBBERY AND OTHER DAMAGED PLANTINGS WITHIN THE PROJECT RIGHT-OF-WAY IS PART OF CLEARING AND GRUBBING. FOR THOSE DESIGNATED TO REMAIN SHALL BE REPLACED WITHIN 72 HOURS OF REMOVAL AND ARE TO BE THOROUGHLY WATERED—IN. NO SEPARATE
- PAVED SURFACES, PAVEMENT MARKERS AND MARKINGS SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM DAMAGE BY TRACKED EQUIPMENT.
- IRON RODS DISTURBED DURING CONSTRUCTION ARE TO BE REPLACED BY A REGISTERED PUBLIC LAND SURVEYOR FOR THE ORIGINAL PROPERTY OWNER AT NO SEPARATE PAY.
- 11. CONSTRUCTION STAKING WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE CONTRACTOR. TWO COPIES OF STAKING NOTES TO PROVIDED TO THE CITY ENGINEER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION
- 12. THE CITY OR THE CITY'S SURVEYOR SHALL PROVIDE A BENCHMARK OR TEMPORARY BENCHMARK AND SURVEY CONTROLS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN UPDATED RED-LINED RECORD DRAWINGS ON SITE FOR INSPECTION BY THE CITY ENGINEER.
- 14. MOWING, MANTENANCE, AND CLEAN-UP OF THE PROJECT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENT OF SPECIFICATION (NO SEPARATE PAY). MOWING, MAINTENANCE, AND CLEAN-UP IS REQUIRED FOR THE PROJECT LIMITS AND DURATION, RECORDLESS OF THE CONTRACTOR'S SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE
- 15. IT IS THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO STOCKPILE NECESSARY MATERIAL ON-SITE OR AT A SECURED OFF-SITE LOCATION AT NO ADDITIONAL EXPENSE TO THE CITY OF ROSENBERG
- ANY SUITABLE EXCAVATED MATERIAL ON THE PROJECT WHICH IS AVAILABLE AT THE TIME OF NEED; WHETHER FROM STORM SEWER, ROADWAY, AND/OR CHANNEL EXCAVATION, SHALL BE USED BEFORE BORROW IS BROUGHT ON-SITE.
- 16. MANHOLES, JUNCTION BOXES, INLETS, AND RISERS ARE TO BE PRE-CAST OR CAST IN PLACE.

### STORM SEWER

- ADEQUATE DRAINAGE SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION AND ANY DRAINAGE DITCH OR STRUCTURE DISTURBED DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE RESTORED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE OWNING AUTHORITY.
- REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE STORM SEWERS SHALL BE ASTM C76, CLASS III, WALL B WITH RUBBER GASKET IN ACCORDANCE WITH SPECIFICATIONS.
- TRENCH SAFETY SYSTEMS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL TRENCH EXCAVATION UTILIZED ON THIS PROJECT. TRENCH SAFETY SYSTEMS SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARDS: SUBPART—"EXCAVATIONS, TRENCHING AND SHORING" PROPOSED RULE (29 CFG PART 1926) AS PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER VOL. 52, NO. 72 DATED APRIL 15, 1987 OR LATEST AMENDMENTS THERETO.
