



GENERAL NOTES

1. Flogs ottoched to signs where shown are REQUIRED.

2. Ail traffic control devices illustrated are REQUIRED, except those denoted with the triangle symbol may be anisted when stated alsewhere in the pions, or for routine maintenance works, when approved by the Engineer.

3. The CB3-4 RE PREPARED to \$100° sign may be instatled after the CR20-40 "ONE LAME ROAD AMEAD" sign, but proper sign spacing shall be maintained.

4. Sign spacing may be increased or an additional CR20-10 "ROAD MORK AMEAD" sign may be used if advance worning chead of the flagger or R1-2 "TIELD" sign is less than 1500 feet.

5. A Shadow Vehicle with a TMA should be used anytime it can be positioned 30 to 100 feet in advance of the area of area exposure without adversely affecting the performance or quality of the work. If workers are no longer present but road or work conditions require the traffic control to remain in place, type 3 Borricodes or other channelizing devices may be substituted for the Shadow Vehicle and TMA.

TCP (1-20)

RI-2 "TIELD" sign traffic control may be used on projects with approaches that have obequate signt distance. For projects in urban areas, work spaces should be no longer than one half city black. In cural areas on roadways with less than 2000 ADT, work


spaces should be no longer than 400 feet.

8. R1-2 "YIELD" sign with R1-2eP "TO OMICHING TRAFFIC" plaque shall be placed on a support of a 7 foot minimum mounting helpts.

TCP (1-2b)

9. Floggers should use two-way radios or other methods of communication to control traffic.
10. Length of work space should be based on the obility of floggers to communicate.
11. If the work space is located near or horizontal or vertical curve, the buffer distances should be increased in order to maintain adequate stopping signi distance to the flogger and a queue of stopped verhicles (see toole above).
12. Channel Izing devices on the center-line may be amitted when a pliat con't seeding traffic and approved by the Engineer.
13. Floggers should use 24" STOPS.ON poodles to control traffic. Flogs should be limited to emergency situations.

For construction or maintenance contract work, specific project requirements for shadow vehicles can snadow vehicles can be found in the project CENERAL NOTES for Item 502, Borricades, Signs and Traffic Handling.
