This letter shall serve as notice to the governing body of the City of Stafford (the "City") that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County intends to call an election on or about February 12, 2019 to create a County Assistance District ("District") pursuant to Chapter 387, Local Government Code, within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction from; the intersections of Fifth Street and FM 2234 to Avenue E. The primary purpose of this District is to promote economic development along the Fifth Street area.

This notice is required to be given to a municipality by Section 387.003(b-1) of the Texas Local Government Code if a proposed district includes any territory of that municipality and must be sent by certified mail, no later than the 60<sup>th</sup> day before the date the Commissioners Court calls the election. The Commissioners Court intends to call a May 2019 election. The governing body of the municipality may exclude the territory of the municipality from the proposed district by sending notice by certified mail to the Commissioners Court no later than 45 days after this certified letter is received.

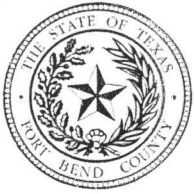
