REVISED RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the County Court of Commissioners finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Fort Bend County, that the Victim Case Coordination Program be operated for the fiscal years 2017-2019; and

WHEREAS, the County Court of Commissioners agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division program funds, the County Court of Commissioners assures that the funds will be returned to the State grant administrator, the Office of the Governor, in full; and

WHEREAS, the County Court of Commissioners previously designated Robert E. Hebert, Fort Bend County Judge as the grantee's authorized official on February 14, 2017.

WHEREAS, the County Court of Commissioners now designates KP George, Fort Bend County Judge as the grantee's authorized official, to reflect the new holder of the office of County Judge. The authorized official is given the power to apply, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Court of Commissioners approves submission of the grant application listed above to the Office of the Governor.

RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, The Fort Bend County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Fort Bend County, that the Victim Case Coordination Program be operated for the 2018-2019 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, The Fort Bend County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, The Fort Bend County Commissioners Court has authorized the County Judge, Robert Hebert to electronically apply for the grant; and has further authorized the County Judge to accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the grant applicant;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court approves submission of the Grant application for the Victim Case Coordination Program to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division not to exceed \$71,666 with \$19,025 local match for a total project cost of \$90,691.
