

# FORT BEND COUNTY RESOLUTION

## IN SUPPORT OF CREATION OF THE JONES CREEK FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT A DISTRICT TO PROVIDE A LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CREATION OF FLOOD CONTROL AND DRAINAGE INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE JONES CREEK WATERSHED

**WHEREAS**, the Jones Creek Watershed is generally located in central Fort Bend County in unincorporated areas near the cities of Richmond and Rosenberg; and

**WHEREAS**, there are thousands of property owners and residents living in a naturally low-lying and flood-prone area adjacent to Jones Creek, outside the boundaries of any existing Municipal Utility District or other local government district which can help with funding their needed infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, recent years of flooding and record rains from Hurricane Harvey have demonstrated the strong need for additional flood control and drainage infrastructure to protect the lives and property of a growing population within the Jones Creek watershed; and


**WHEREAS**, the creation of the Jones Creek Flood Control District would provide for the public election of a Board of Directors, charged with exercising the power, right, privilege, or function conferred by general law on a flood control district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, as applicable to Fort Bend County and essential to the flood control project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, finds that this resolution serves a public purpose.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, Fort Bend County Commissioners Court supports legislation that will create the Jones Creek Flood Control District.
