

# FORT BEND COUNTY RESOLUTION

## IN SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 956 MODIFICATIONS TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE 387, DISBANDING COUNTY ASSISTANCE DISTRICTS

**WHEREAS,** Local Government Code Chapter 387 gives counties the authority to create County Assistance Districts for the purpose of spending revenue on government services within a defined district; and

**WHEREAS,** Districts may be created, but there is no provision under Local Government Code 387 to officially abolish a County Assistance District; and

**WHEREAS,** An administrative burden would be placed on the governing body tasked with administering the district if the district is no longer needed; and


**WHEREAS,** The administrative burden on the governing body would be a waste of government resources; and


**WHEREAS,** Supporting this legislation serves a public purpose and could assist in creating more efficiency in special districts and county governments.


