

FORT BEND COUNTY RESOLUTION

IN SUPPORT OF LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY FOR A COUNTY ASSISTANCE DISTRICT TO MAKE GRANTS OR LOANS MODIFICATIONS TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE 387, ALLOWING COUNTY ASSISTANCE DISTRICTS TO MAKE LOANS

WHEREAS, Local Government Code Chapter 387 gives County Assistance Districts the ability to accept a grant or loan from the federal government, state and local governments, and public or private individuals; and

WHEREAS, There is no provision under Local Government Code 387 to allow County Assistance Districts the ability to make a grant or loan to local governments or other County Assistance Districts; and


WHEREAS, legislation allowing County Assistance Districts to make loans and grants to other districts will allow greater economy and cost sharing on jointly funded projects; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, finds that this resolution serves a public purpose.


