**ORDER REVISING THE FORT BEND COUNTY SIGNAGE POLICY
TO BE EFFECTIVE MARCH 26, 2019**

On this the 26th day of March, 2019, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, sitting as the governing body of Fort Bend County, upon motion of Commissioner Meyers, seconded by Commissioner Prestage, duly put and carried;

That the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court does hereby approve the below revision to the County Signage Policy that was adopted February 2, 1997 as shown underlined below.

County Signage Policy

County Signage will be generic in nature regarding the following:

1. Outside of buildings and road signs are to be identified only by department or title—without using appointed or elected official's names excluding project signs, other temporary signs, and plaques on county facilities.
2. Reserved parking spaces are to be identified by numbers (no titles or names of appoints or elected officials).
3. All county owned or leased vehicles are to contain only those inscriptions required by state law. No vehicle should bear the name of any person: whether elected, appointed; deceased or living.
