**General Information**

1. Describe the proposed project(s) for which the funds will be used. \*

Fort Bend County provides general public demand response, deviated fixed route, and commuter services. All services operate Monday through Friday (excluding County Holidays).

Demand Response services operate to accommodate first drop-off by 8:00 am and last pick-up by 5:00 pm. Demand Response trips are provided within the County limits and/or to destinations in adjoining counties within one (1) mile of the Fort Bend County line. Advanced reservations are required and can be requested up to thirty (30) calendar days in advance. Requests are taken on a first come first serve basis. The County provides additional services such as the Ambassador Program wherein passenger assistants help passengers with disabilities to and from their destinations. The County also continues planning with human service agency transportation providers within the County and continues to stay involved in the regions public transportation efforts.

Deviated fixed route and commuter services operate in both the morning and evening as listed on the route schedules. The deviated fixed route services are limited to within the County limits with timed stops at designated locations within this area. Vehicles can deviate short distances from the route to pick-up and drop-off clients or to accommodate pick-up and drop-offs at high demand locations. Commuter services are provided to Greenway Plaza, Galleria, and Texas Medical Center areas of Houston from park and ride locations in Sugar Land and Rosenberg. The County is also in the process of constructing an additional park and ride facility along the Westpark Toll Road in northwest Fort Bend County.

2. Provide a description of how the need/demand for the proposed project(s) was determined. \*

In 2005, Fort Bend County Public Transportation Department was formed providing Demand Response services within Fort Bend County and Commuter services going to the Greenway Plaza and Galleria areas. We have since added Commuter Services to the Texas Medical Center. Funding would provide continued service to individuals in rural areas as well as to individuals who might not have other means of transportation. The surrounding community benefit would be continuity of service to the riders in the areas Fort Bend County currently serves.

As indicated in the project description, Fort Bend County has targeted multiple agencies, organizations, and institutions in the pursuit of coordinating existing transportation services and implementing new transportation services. Funding obtained will continue to support all of our coordination activities and projects.

3. Describe the anticipated benefits of the project. \*

Fort Bend County has a population of more than 764,000. In FY18, the County completed over 392,000 trips in the current provided service area. The County is helping to bring a better quality of life to individuals, families, communities, and businesses. Our services offer personal mobility and freedom for people from every walk of life by providing options to get to work, go to school, visit friends, or get to a doctor's appointment as well as a reduction in Vehicle Miles Traveled. The Project will not only directly reduce emissions by eliminating passenger-vehicles, but it will also reduce emission by alleviating congestion on the road.

First Transit is currently providing both purchase of service and ambassador services . We are currently negotiating a contract for bus services and are in the process of procuring ambassador services. TxDOT PTC has approved the solicitations issued for both services .

**Schedule A Ride:**

- To schedule a ride, call 281-633-RIDE (7433) or 1-866-751-TRIP (8747) and select option 2, "Fort Bend County Reservations". You may call Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Information needed to schedule a ride:
  - Name
  - Home address
  - Telephone Number
  - Pick-up Location
  - Address of Destination
  - Requested Pick-Up Time and/or Appointment Time.
- Reservations may be made 30 days in advance or up to one business day in advance of the appointment time.
- Rides are typically scheduled for first "destination" drop-off by 8 a.m. & last pick-up will be no later than 5 p.m.
- Repeat rides may be scheduled in advance.
- Rides will be accepted on a "time and space" available basis.
- Time and space is reserved for registered New Freedom passengers.

- If a passenger needs to cancel or change their ride, they must call the Reservationists at 281-633-RIDE (7433) or 1-866-751-TRIP (8747) as soon as possible. Cancellations received 2 hours or less before a scheduled ride will be considered a "late cancel" trip.



**Passenger Guidelines:**

- This is a shared ride service.
- Passengers must be ready 15 minutes before scheduled pick up time. If passenger is not ready, or decides not to go, the trip will be considered a "no show" trip. If a passenger receives three "no show" trips in a one year period, their services can be suspended.
- All passengers must wear seat restraints.
- Passenger must provide approved seat restraints for children 40 pounds or less.
- Passengers 12 years or younger must be accompanied by another person 18 years or older.

**Service Information:**

- Fare for a one-way trip is \$1.00 per person each way.
- Service is curb-to-curb with door-to-door service available for people with disabilities. This request must be made during the time of your reservation.
- Rides are provided within Fort Bend County. Fort Bend County Public Transit currently offers three fixed route commuter services into Harris County; Fort Bend Express Greenway Plaza, Uptown/Galleria, and Texas Medical Center.
- Fort Bend County Transit is closed and does not provide service on County holidays.

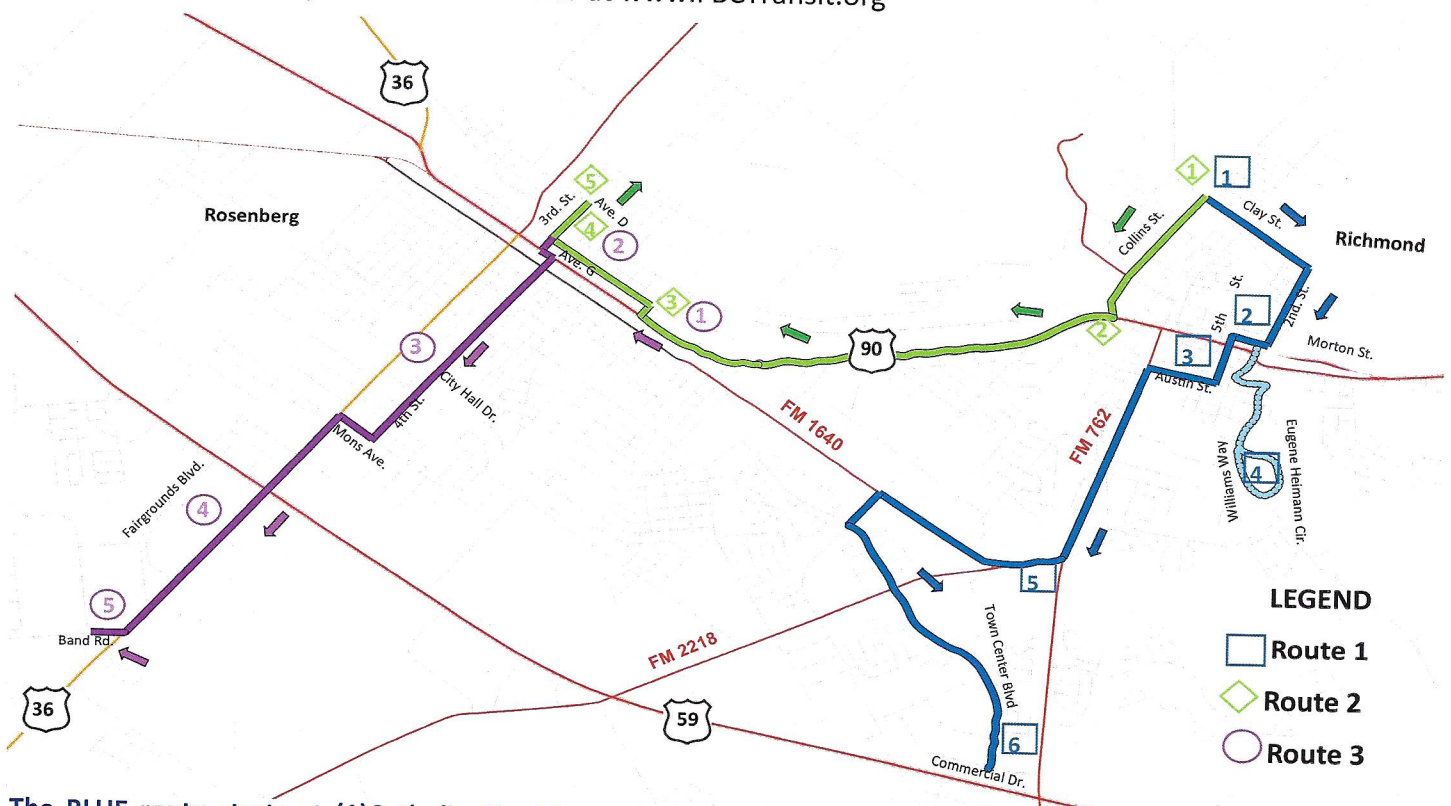
# A New Public Transportation Service For the Richmond - Rosenberg Area

The Fort Bend County Point Deviation Bus Service will provide weekday service along major thoroughfares in the Richmond—Rosenberg area, with designated stops to municipal offices, shopping, medical and community service locations.

The buses can deviate up to 3/4 mile from the routes to pick up or drop off riders who have made reservations. These requests/reservations are based on availability.

Riders have both the benefit of a dependable bus schedule Mondays through Fridays and the ability to have direct pickup or drop-off if needed. Fares are \$1.00 per person.

The **GREEN** connector route travels between Richmond and Rosenberg along Hwy 90, with (1)Catholic Charities, (3) Fiesta and (4)Rosenberg Post Office as transfer stops. This route also stops at (2) Bend Medical Center, and the (5) North Rosenberg Neighborhood Resource Office.

The **PURPLE** route travels through Rosenberg with scheduled stops at (1)Fiesta, (2)Rosenberg Post Office, (3) Rosenberg City Hall, (4)Fairgrounds Park and Ride and the (5)Bud O’Shieles Community Center.

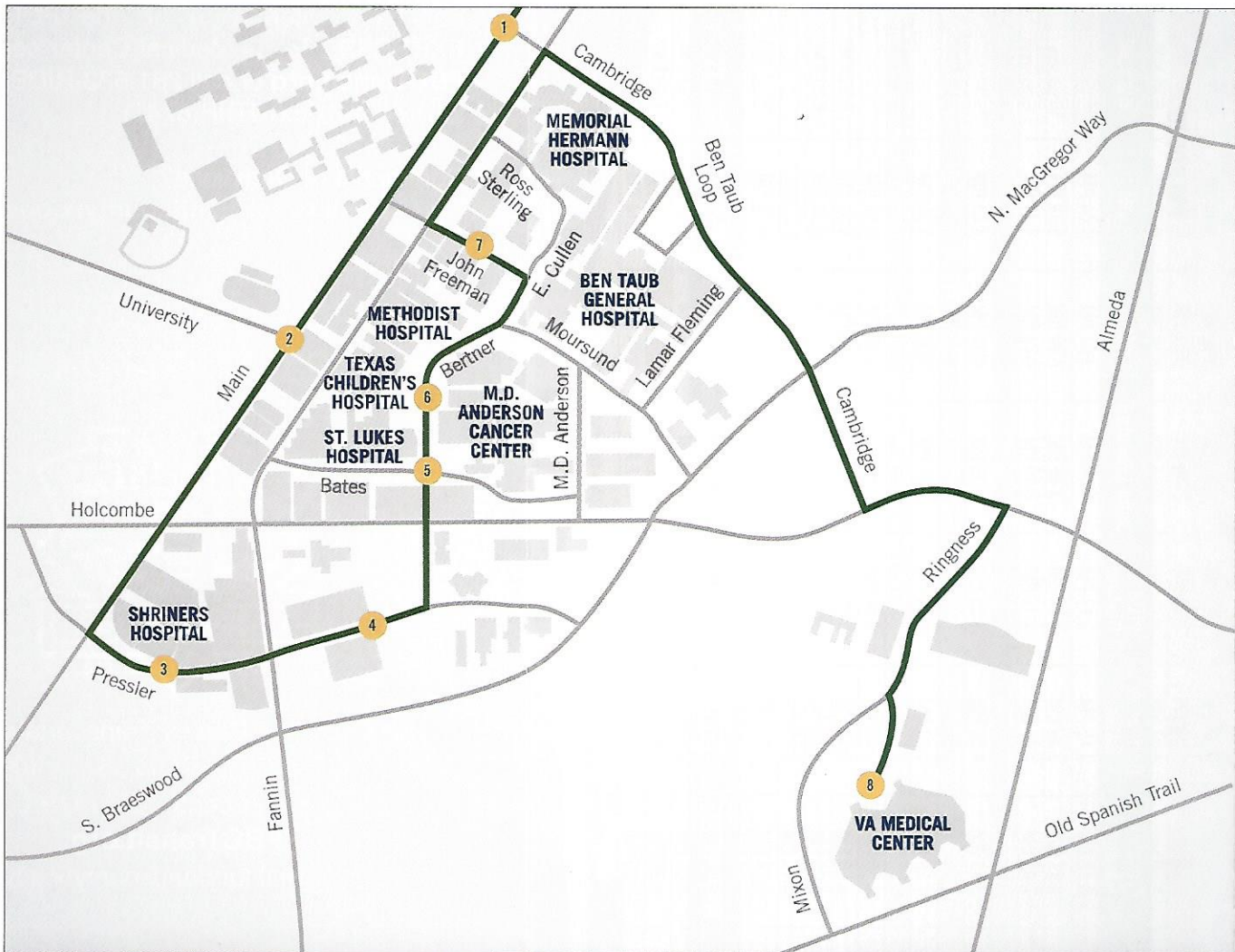

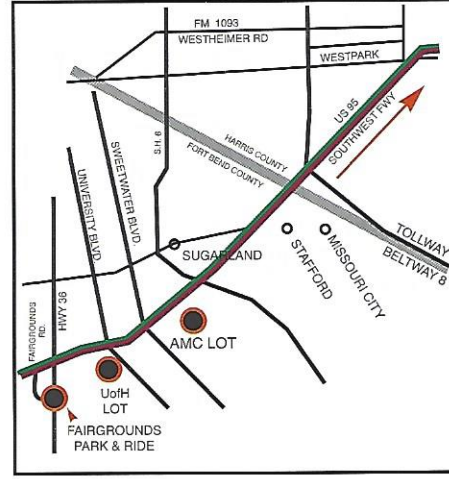
