

**FORT BEND COUNTY RESOLUTION
OF NO OBJECTION TO
FULSHEAR'S DESIRED ANNEXATION OF THE TEXAS HERITAGE PARKWAY
RIGHT-OF-WAY**

WHEREAS, the City has a stated desire to provide utility services to the residents and businesses that occupy the City; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County (the "County") believes annexation serves the best interests of the residents and businesses that occupy the City; and


WHEREAS, the County believes annexation serves the best interests of the County residents and will relieve the County of future maintenance costs associated with the roadway; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, finds that this resolution serves a public purpose.




