

FORT BEND COUNTY RESOLUTION

**IN OPPOSITION OF
OAKVILLE RANCH R.V. RESORT**

WHEREAS, the proposed Oakville Ranch R.V. Resort is located in northwest unincorporated Fort Bend County, off County Line Road near the City of Simonton and the Brazos River; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Oakville Ranch R.V. Resort poses a serious risk to both human life and personal property due to the resort's proximity to the Brazos River, low land elevation, and a lack of roads which could hold a mass evacuation during times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the proposed site poses a risk to the outlying community as there is a lack of reasonable evacuation routes available to move a high volume of traffic and allow for safe evacuations during times of emergency; and


WHEREAS, the City of Simonton has previously assisted in evacuation operations in this area, and has expressed serious concerns about the possibility of a major concentration of recreational vehicles in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, finds that this resolution serves a public purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Fort Bend County Commissioners Court opposes the development of the Oakville Ranch R.V. Resort.


