Award Executive Summary: This grant is Fort Bend County FY 2019 CMAQ Flex funds in the federal amount of \$17,200,000 for the Construction of the Fort Bend County Transit Administration and Operations Facility. Fort Bend County owns the property and is leveraging the value of the property as a portion of the local match along with funds in bond revenue (\$3,862,208 local cash match, \$437,792 land value).

The Project will consist of approximately 30 acres located on a 209 acre tract of land owned by Fort Bend County. The property is located in the City of Rosenberg on the corner of Stella and Cottonwood School Road, approximately 730 yards west of I-69. The Project will have accommodations for administrative activities, reservations, scheduling, customer service, dispatch, traffic management, fare sales and collections, and driver work/break area. The fueling island will include; a bus wash facility, parts wash station and a fare collection station. The maintenance building will accommodate bus and service vehicle repair as well as inventory storage for parts, tires, batteries, etc.

Funds are currently being expended under a Letter of No Prejudice. Remaining funding for this project is being paid from the following grant awards:

FY18 5307 TX-2019-088-00 (land value was not used)

The location for Land Match property is the corner of Future Bamore Road and Klaycke Road Rosenberg in Fort Bend County, Texas. The FTA approved value is \$437,792. Please refer to the attached approval.
