Honorable Judge George:

Fort Bend County Engineering Department has received and reviewed a request (letter attached) from Odyssey Engineering Group, for Fort Bend County to sponsor a project for a public road widening of the 9<sup>th</sup> Street tie-in and right turn lane addition at Damon Street at Hwy 90A on behalf of Mandola Farms. The roadway connection improvements will improve traffic flow to Mandola Farms.

Any and all cost involved with the project will be borne by Mandola Farms. There will be no cost to Fort Bend County.

**WHEREAS**, the funding for such sponsorship of the project is to be provided through sources other than Fort Bend County.

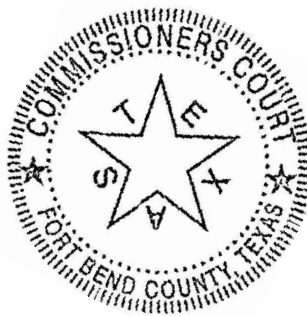
