

RESOLUTION NO. R-2970

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSENBERG, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROSENBERG, TEXAS, AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF ROSENBERG, TEXAS, AND FORT BEND COUNTY FOR COUNTY MANAGED ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FORT BEND COUNTY MOBILITY PROJECT NO. 17118 - BRYAN ROAD – RECLAIMED WATER LINE, IN THE ESTIMATED COST OF \$236,297.00.

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WHEREAS, in 2017 the citizens of Fort Bend County voted to approve the issuance of general obligation bonds that allows the County to participate with other local governmental entities to fund certain regional street and road improvements and associated drainage facilities (“Mobility Projects”) that are funded in part by the state or federal government; and

WHEREAS, the Project is the construction of reclaimed water line in the portion of Bryan Road located between the City limit line and FM 2977, and such Project is desired by the City and the County; and

WHEREAS, the County may not expend proceeds of bond issues or taxes levied pursuant to Article III, Section 52 (b) or (c) of the Texas Constitution on city streets that are not integral parts of or connecting links with county roads or state highways in accordance with Section of the TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE; and

WHEREAS, the Parties assert that the Project is part of a City street that is an integral part of or a connecting link with county roads or state highways in accordance with Section 251.012 of the TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County agree to participate in this Project according to the terms of this Agreement; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSENBERG:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Rosenberg hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and the Mayor to execute an Interlocal Agreement for County-Managed Road Construction Project Fort Bend County Mobility Project No. 17118 – Bryan Road – Reclaimed Water Line (Agreement).

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and the Mayor to execute any documentation necessary to facilitate said project.

Section 3. A copy of said Interlocal Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof for all purposes.
