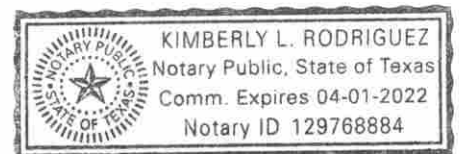

### Notice of Public Hearing

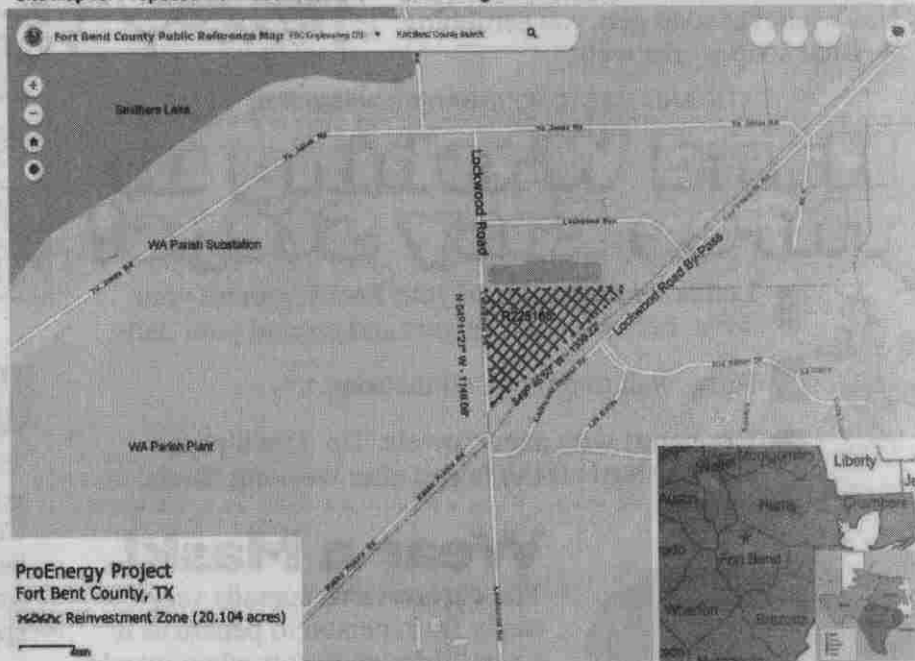
Pursuant to Sections 312.201 and 312.401 of the Texas Tax Code, notice is hereby given that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, will conduct a hearing at its regular meeting on September 8, 2020, at 1:00 p.m., in the Commissioners Courtroom, 2nd floor, 401 Jackson St., Richmond, Texas. If an order is issued at the state, local or federal level that limits or prohibits in-person gatherings, the hearing will be conducted remotely by videoconference.

The public hearing is being held for the purpose of establishing a reinvestment zone which will enable the County to abate taxes on personal property and real property improvements within this reinvestment zone. All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting and offer any comments on the designation of this zone. All comments will be considered by the Commissioners Court.
