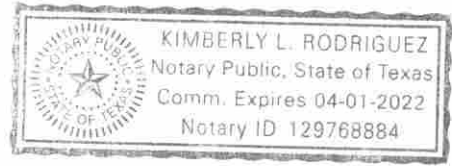



NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas (the "County"), will meet at the Commissioners Court Room, 401 Jackson Street, Richmond, Texas 77469 at 1:00 p.m. on the 8th day of December, 2020, which is the time and place tentatively set for the passage of an order and such other action as may be deemed necessary to authorize the issuance of the County's certificates of obligation, in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$25,000,000 payable from ad valorem taxation and from a limited and subordinate pledge of the net revenues derived from prisoner housing contracts, bearing interest at any rate or rates not to exceed the maximum interest rate now or hereafter authorized by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the Commissioners Court at the time of issuance, and maturing over a period of years not to exceed thirty (30) years from the date thereof, for the purpose of evidencing the indebtedness of the County for all or any part of the costs associated with (i) the construction, acquisition, renovation and equipment of improvements to the Texas Heritage Parkway project and all related signage, drainage, traffic lights, and including the acquisition of approximately 30 acres of property located along the planned route of the Texas Heritage Parkway in the Enoch Latham Survey, Abstract No. 50, Fort Bend County, for right of way and detention purposes, and (ii) the cost of professional services incurred in connection therewith.

It is estimated that the combined principal and interest required to pay the certificates is \$48,287,500. Such estimate is provided for illustrative purposes only, and is based on an assumed interest rate of 5.00%. As of the date of this notice, the aggregate principal amount outstanding of tax-supported debt obligations of the County is \$785,851,310, and based on the County's expectations, as of the date of this notice the combined principal and interest required to pay all of the outstanding tax-supported debt obligations of the on time and in full is \$1,120,102,959. Such amounts are derived from projections obtained from the County's financial advisor based upon current market conditions and is provided from the County without assurance that such projections will be realized. The County cannot guarantee that such conditions will continue through the date of the sale of the Certificates.
