**WHEREAS,** The operation of roadside vending can detrimentally affect the amenity of the neighborhoods and the surrounding area; and

**WHEREAS,** The sale of food, of any description, without proper inspections could cause illness and health and safety concerns; and

**WHEREAS,** Roadside vending creates traffic problems or increases an existing traffic problems and creates pedestrian/vehicle safety issues; and

**WHEREAS,** Banning roadside vending will protect the welfare of Fort Bend County residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:**

THAT ON DECEMBER 15, 2020, THE FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT, MEETING AS A BODY IN RICHMOND, TEXAS, ADOPTS THIS RESOLUTION AND URGES THE TEXAS LEGISLATURE TO ENACT STRONGER LAWS TO PROTECT THE WELFARE OF FORT BEND COUNTY BY BANNING ROADSIDE VENDING.
