IN SUPPORT OF
HOUSE BILL REQUIRING TCEQ NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, the TCEQ monitors and regulates the potable water standards in the State of Texas and

WHEREAS, the TCEQ is first to be aware of a potential public health threat; and

WHEREAS, the TCEQ has the capacity to notify downstream users and purveyors of potential public health threats in a public water system.

WHEREAS, The citizens of the State of Texas and Fort Bend County would be better protected and served having been made aware of potential health threat;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Fort Bend County Commissioners Court supports a House Bill requiring the TCEQ to notify downstream municipalities within an identified public water system immediately of any discovery of potentially contaminated or compromised water within that system.

PASSED and APPROVED on December 15, 2020.

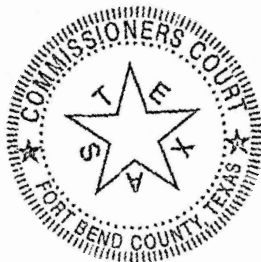
