


**PUBLIC NOTICE OF A MEETING AT WHICH
FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT WILL CONSIDER
ACTION ON THE GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR TAX ABATEMENTS**

Pursuant to Chapter 312 of the Texas Tax Code, Sections 312.002(c) and 312.002 (c-1), notice is hereby given that Fort Bend County Commissioners Court will consider taking action on the Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements at their regular meeting to be held on Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. Due to emergency conditions, this hearing may be conducted by telephone and/or videoconference.

The Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements are effective for two years from the date adopted, and before a governing body can adopt, amend, repeal, or reauthorize those guidelines, members of the public are provided an opportunity to be heard at a public hearing.

The Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector serves as the compliance authority for Tax Abatement agreements. Because of this compliance role, Carmen P. Turner, MPA, Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector is providing input for the restatement of the current Fort Bend County Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements, along with the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court and the general public.

The Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements to be considered by Commissioners Court will be included in the Notice of Meeting to be posted by the Office of County Judge KP George for the regular meeting date of February 23, 2021. This notice does not replace any notice required for open meetings under Texas Government Code Section 551, but is in addition to any other notice required by law.
