

17. DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

From the USACE Galveston District, head north on I-45. Take exit 32 for Sam Houston Tollway W. Head west on Sam Houston Tollway W. Take exit for Farm-to-Market 521 and head south. Turn right onto Trammel-Fresno Road. Turn right onto Nail Road. Head north on Nail Road until you come to the tract which runs east and west.

18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)

In order to construct the proposed project, the applicant proposes to fill 3.15 acres of non-adjacent wetlands in order to extend the existing Lake Olympia Parkway within a 67.4-acre (14,136 LF) tract of land.

19. Project Purpose (Describe the reason or purpose of the project, see instructions)

The purpose of the proposed project is to extend Lake Olympia Parkway. The proposed Lake Olympia Parkway extension will provide a direct connection between FM 521 and Fort Bend County Toll Road. This roadway connection is needed in order to accommodate the growing transportation demands associated with current and future population growth in Fort Bend County, TX.

The Applicant has also designed the detention areas so that a majority of Wetland 10 will be avoided. As there are no planned impacts to jurisdictional wetlands or waters, no compensatory mitigation is proposed at this time.
