RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT
OFSheriff's Office Justice Assistance Grant Proposal to Fund Automated License Plate
Readers #4298701

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County desires to disrupt the illicit supply chain of trafficking in humans, drugs, weapons, contraband, and bulk-cash smuggling that traverses thoroughfares in Fort Bend County; and

WHEREAS technology exists to capture images of wanted and stolen vehicles that are transformed into algorithms to be read by law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the Fort Bend County to disrupt the illicit supply chain with strategic placement of license plate readers; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County agrees to provide all applicable support for the grant application to be submitted to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division before February 11, 2021;


WHEREAS, Fort Bend County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division funds, Fort Bend County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County designates the Honorable Judge KP George, County Judge of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court, as the County's authorized official giving him the power to electronically apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Fort Bend County approves submission of the grant application for the project, "Disrupting the Illicit Supply Chain with Strategic Placement of License Plate Readers," to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division for an amount of \$79,602.00.
