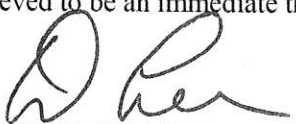

Within the specified project limits, Ransom Road exists as two-lane undivided asphalt roadway. The roadway is located within a 60-ft right-of-way (ROW). Fort Bend County MUD 121 levee is located on the south side of the roadway. The project includes reconstruction of the roadway to include a through lane in each direction and a continuous two-way left turn lane. The proposed paving will be 8" concrete paving with 8" lime treated subgrade.

The proposed roadway profile will be raised over 3 feet in some areas. The project also includes regrading of roadside ditches. Some ditch regrading extends outside of the right-of-way on both the south and north sides of the roadway. Temporary construction easements have been obtained for construction of work outside of the right-of-way. A culvert and outfall will be constructed near the eastern project limits. The total length of the project is approximately 2656 linear feet. The construction does not include any proposed water lines or sanitary sewer lines nor does it include any ROW acquisition.
