

RESOLUTION REQUESTING COMMISSIONERS COURT OF  
FORT BEND COUNTY TO APPOINT DIRECTORS

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, has heretofore appointed Jared Biermann, Joseph Sheets, and Dan Noltensmeyer as directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 20 (the "District"), for terms that expire on August 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, confers jurisdiction on the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, to appoint the directors of the District; and

WHEREAS, Jared Biermann has resigned from the Board of Directors of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District hereby requests that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, appoint Charles Gregory Baker, to the vacant position to serve as director for the District for the term ending August 28, 2023, or until a successor shall be appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, Charles Gregory Baker is over twenty-one years of age, is resident citizen of Fort Bend County, and is otherwise qualified by law to serve as directors of the District; Now, Therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 20 THAT:

Section 1: The Board of Directors hereby requests that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, appoint Charles Gregory Baker as director of the District for the lawful term of office, which expires on August 28, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas ("Commissioners Court"), has heretofore appointed the Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 20 (the "District") to serve for lawful four-year terms of office expiring August 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court desires to appoint Charles Gregory Baker to serve as a replacement for Jeff Singer for the District for Jared Biermann's term of office expiring August 28, 2023, or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Sheets, Dan Noltensmeyer, and Charles Gregory Baker are over twenty-one years of age, are resident citizens of the State of Texas, are otherwise qualified by law to serve as directors of the District, and are not disqualified from serving as directors of the District by reason of any law; and

WHEREAS, Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, confers jurisdiction on the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas to appoint the Directors of the District; Now Therefore,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE AND COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2: Charles Gregory Baker is hereby appointed as a Director of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 20 to serve in that capacity for the terms of office which expire on August 28, 2023, or until his successors shall be appointed and qualified.

Section 3: As a Director, Charles Gregory Baker is required by the FORT BEND COUNTY REVISED ORDER ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR COMMISSIONERS COURT LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT DIRECTOR APPOINTEES UNDER THE TEXAS WATER CODE APPROVED ON NOVEMBER 26, 2019 to comply with the following Annual Education/Training Requirements:


- A. All LID board members will earn a minimum of 6 hours of relevant education or training on topics such as: National Flood Insurance Program; FEMA - floodplain mapping; US Army Corps; RIP Certification; Waters of the US; Emergency Operations; Director Ethics; Open Meeting Act; Public Information Act; Conflicts of interest.
- B. The annual time shall begin on the date of the Director's appointment and shall expire on the day prior to the anniversary date.
- C. The Fort Bend County Drainage District will assist Directors in locating opportunities within Fort Bend County each year to meet the education/training requirements such that no Director will be required to go out of county or out of state. FBCDD will make every attempt to identify courses hosted on week-ends or after normal business hours so that being a LID Director does not interfere with the Director's profession.
- D. The attorney for each LID will maintain the education/training compliance for each LID Director and will annually (between January 1st and April 1st) inform FBCDD of the compliance status of each Director.
- E. Non-compliance with the education/training requirements will subject an appointed Director to removal, per Section 57.053.

Section 3: A copy of the Order shall be recorded in the minutes of this Court.

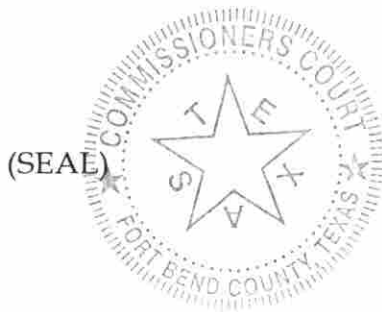
