When the following were heard and the following orders were passed:

1. Call to Order.

Call to Order by Judge KP George at 1:00 p.m.

2. Conduct Budget Workshops.

Pamela Gubbels, Director of Finance & Investments stated Mr. Jordan Wise, Chief Appraiser, has suggested a 9.5% reduction in the preliminary values with the values received in April to when the values are certified in July. The estimated values for Fort Bend County and Drainage District are \$78.2 billion, with the County having a 2.27% increase and Drainage a 3.05% increase. The total Budget Request for 2022 is \$457.9 million, which is an 8.14% increase over the FY2021 adopted budget. The total request was \$27 million over target and does not include \$22.2 million for CIP and does not include salary increases. Included are 249 new positions for a total of \$23.6 million, 95 reclassifications and 107 replacement vehicle requests and 80 addition to fleet requests for a total of \$10 million.

Commissioner Meyers indicated, in regards to the reclassification requests, Human Resources will be doing a compensation study and suggests waiting to make a determination after the study is complete.

Commissioners Morales asked the court to consider that last year the County did not give a cost of living raise to County employees, which is justified for the kind of year it was. Before adding positions, Commissioner asks to take into consideration maintaining and keeping the employees the County currently has and consider an increase of cost of living over adding other positions.
