• Fort Bend Green has been coordinating with Keep Beautiful organizations within Fort Bend County to explore developing a Keep Fort Bend Beautiful group.




GIS Greenspace Acreage Project

- Fort Bend Green recently worked with the County to inventory existing public greenspaces not currently captured within their GIS mapping system including open spaces (landscape reserves, park areas), natural features (lakes, rivers, drainage, and detention areas) and utility corridors (levee, CenterPoint, etc.).
 - Reached out to over 197 special districts
 - An additional 44,000 greenspace acreage captured

Where are we now – 44,847 Acres

- After Research with Fort Bend County GIS that now includes NBI (nature-based infrastructure)
 - Open Space: park, common area, landscape reserves
 - Water: lake, river, drainage, detention, bayou, etc.
 - Easement: levee, CenterPoint, access, etc.
