

**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER REGARDING REDISTRICTING
INCLUDING CERTAIN DESIGNATIONS AND CONFIRMATIONS**

On this day there came to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, (the "Court") the matter of certain designations and confirmations regarding the offices of Fort Bend County Constables and Justices of the Peace, and the Agreements for Additional Law Enforcement Services.

WHEREAS, the Court adopted a Redistricting Plan for Commissioners Court precincts based on population data extracted from the 2020 Census pursuant to Article 5, Section 18 of the Texas Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the changes to the boundary lines under the Redistricting Plan and the subsequent Amended Order adopting the same plan for Constable and Justice of the Peace precincts affected certain elected officials based on residency and the offices they were elected to hold; and

WHEREAS, the changes to the boundary lines also affected certain areas served by Constables authorized to perform services under the 2021-2022 Agreements for Additional Law Enforcement Services; and

WHEREAS, the Court desires to clarify the impact of such boundary line changes to the offices of Fort Bend County Constables and Justices of the Peace the Court by designation and confirmation office holders, locations, and service providers under the 2021-2022 Agreements for Additional Law Enforcement Services in accordance with the Texas Constitution and pertinent statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, as a result of redistricting and the effect of the new boundary lines on the offices of Fort Bend County Constables and Justices of the Peace, and based on the current known residences of the office holders, the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court, through a majority vote, hereby Orders that the following designations shall be hereinafter utilized in Fort Bend County, Texas, as follows:

1. The offices of Fort Bend County Constables shall be held by the elected officials, and located in the buildings as shown below, effective January 1, 2022:

2. The offices of Fort Bend County Justices of the Peace shall be held by the elected officials, and for purposes of meeting and other legal notices, at the locations shown below, hereby designated as the courthouse for each respective Justice of the Peace, effective January 1, 2022:

FURTHER, the Court hereby confirms that the Constable authorized to perform services under the 2021-2022 Agreements for Additional Law Enforcement Services may continue providing services under the executed Agreement without amendment; provided that:

- A. The non-Fort Bend party to the Agreement has been redistricted as of January 1, 2022 (in whole or in part) to the same precinct as the Constable; and
- B. The Constable has complied with Texas Local Government Code Section 86.011 for the appointment of Deputy Constables.
