**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR
 PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and IDS Engineering Group, (hereinafter “Contractor”), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Services on March 26, 2019, (hereinafter “Agreement”) pursuant to SOQ 14-025, as amended by document executed on February 9, 2021, (hereinafter “Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement for additional services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation under the Agreement for the completion of such additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. County shall pay Contractor an additional fifty-five thousand six hundred twenty-nine dollars and no/100 (\$55,629.00), for the services as described in Contractor’s proposal dated December 18, 2020, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed one million three hundred thirty-four thousand five hundred forty-one dollars and no/100 (\$1,334,541.00), authorized as follows:
 - \$422,500.00 under the Agreement;
 - \$856,412.00 under the Amendment; and
 - \$55,629.00 under this Amendment.
3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and any subsequently executed amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without written agreement executed by both parties.
4. The parties hereby agree to extend the Time of Performance under the Agreement to end no later than December 31, 2025.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement and any subsequently executed amendment shall remain unchanged.

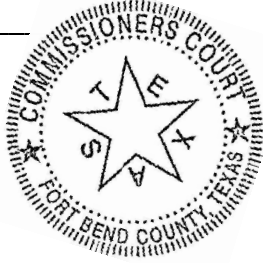



IDS Engineering Group respectfully submits this additional services proposal for the above referenced project to include professional engineering and surveying services. The additional scope of services is as follows:

1. Utility Plan and Profile Drawings (Included in Preparation of PS&E)
Per the 70% Review Comments by the Program Manager, IDS will prepare Utility Plan Sheets identifying the location, depth and owner of private utilities within the project area. This will include 16 new plan sheets which will be separate from the roadway plan drawings.
2. Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) Level A – In the additional services request dated 12-18-2020, IDS included a placeholder for SUE Level A. Upon selection of a SUE Consultant, TSC Engineering, a fee was established for SUE Level A which exceeded the placeholder amount.
3. Traffic Engineering Services - In the additional services request dated 12-18-2020, IDS included a placeholder for Traffic Engineering Services which was provided by the Program Manager. Upon selection of a Traffic Engineering Consultant, InfraTECH, a fee was established for the permanent and temporary signals which exceeded the placeholder amount.
