3. Workshop to receive presentation by the Fort Bend County Drainage District regarding the Brazos River Study.

Mark Vogler, Chief Engineer, Drainage District gave a presentation on the conclusion of the Brazos River Study, which was part of the Watershed Study that started several years ago. Halff & Associates, a consulting firm was brought on to assist with the study. The Brazos River Study consisted of two parts: Hydrology and Hydraulic. Mr. Vogler stated in the short term the County should consider whether this new study will be used as the official map. The levee district will need to certify to the official map and it may be beneficial to lowering the flood plain.

Stacy Slawinski, County Engineer, explained there are two boundaries of the flood plain with this new study and the FEMA approved study. Both boundaries will be looked at during a review and the most stringent boundary will be used.
