The District Attorney's Office respectfully requests authorization from Commissioners Court to apply for the FY2023 Victims of Crime Act grant from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division. The purpose of this program is to provide assistance directly to victims of crime to speed their recovery and aid them through the criminal justice process; including responding to the emotional and physical needs of crime victims; assisting victims in stabilizing their lives; assisting victims to understand and participate in the criminal justice system; and providing victims safety and security.
