The Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office respectfully requests authorization from Commissioners Court to apply for the FY 2021 The Kevin and Avonte Program: Reducing Injury and Death of Missing Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities grant from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), and Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) in the amount of \$120,183.11. This grant will fund ten additional receivers placed at sites around the county, outfit our two helicopters with receiver units and 225 transmitters provided to families with members diagnosed with cognitive conditions such as Alzheimer's and autism.
