Location The project area parcel areas are located north and northwest of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 521 and Highway 6 and southwest of Fresno, Texas, in Fort Bend County, Texas (Figure 2). Area 1 consists of 2 kilometers (1.2 miles) along Westenfeldt, north of Highway 6. Area 2 consists of 0.2 kilometers (0.1 miles) along Rabb Road, east of Teal Bend Boulevard. Area 3 consists of 0.7 kilometers (0.5 miles) along W Sycamore Road, east and west of FM 521. Area 4 consists of an 8.38 acre (3.4 hectares) retention pond immediately adjacent and to the south of the central portion of Area 3. These four area parcels making up the project area consist of existing roads surrounded by neighborhoods, commercial property, utility lines/poles, buried utilities, ditches, undeveloped land/areas (vacant fields), driveways, a retention basin, an elementary school, and railroad tracks. Long Point Creek is west of the project areas.
