

**ORDER SETTING TERMS FOR THE FORT BEND COUNTY
STATUTORY COUNTY COURTS AND JUSTICE OF THE PEACE COURTS**

On the 5th day of July, 2022, at a duly posted and called meeting of the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, on motion of Commissioner Meyers, seconded by Commissioner Morales, duly put and carried.

WHEREAS, Section 25.0016 of the Texas Government Code provides that a Commissioners Court, by order, shall set at least two terms per year for the Statutory County Courts; and

WHEREAS, Section 27.051 of the Texas Government Code establishes the term for the Justice of the Peace Courts and provides that a Commissioners Court, by order, shall establish the time and place for the Justice of the Peace Courts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS that the two terms set for the Fort Bend County Statutory County Courts and the Fort Bend County Justice of the Peace Courts shall be set as follows:

1. January 1 – June 30 and July 1 – December 31 for the 2022 calendar year as ratified by this Order.
2. January 1 – June 30 and July 1 – December 31 for the 2023 calendar year.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, except as provided herein during a Disaster, the place for holding the Fort Bend County Justice of the Peace Courts shall be at the locations listed below, or virtual if authorized by the Texas Supreme Court.


1. Precinct 1, Place 1, 22333 Grand Corner Drive, Katy, Texas 77494
2. Precinct 1, Place 2, 6610 Farm to Market 359 #600, Fulshear, TX 77441
3. Precinct 2, 303 Texas Parkway (FM 2234), Room 107 Missouri City, TX 77489
4. Precinct 3, 12919 Dairy Ashford, Suite 100, Sugar Land, TX 77478
5. Precinct 4, 1517 Eugene Heimann Circle, Suite 100, Richmond, Texas 77469

The days and times for meetings for the Justice of the Peace Courts shall be set as determined by the Justices for each court. Meetings shall also occur as cases may arise and any additional times that the Justices may desire.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, if a Disaster, as defined by Section 418.004 of the Texas Government Code, precludes a Statutory County Court or a Statutory Justice of the Peace Court from holding its terms or locations as ordered by this Commissioners Court, then procedures for the designation of alternative terms, times, and locations for the respective courts shall be followed pursuant to Sections 25.0016(b) and 27.0515 of the Texas Government Code.
