KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WE, TX-Morrow Construction Co., Inc. whose (address, phone) is 403 Corporate Center Drive, Suite 201, Stockbridge, GA 30281, hereinafter called the Principal, and The Cincinnati Insurance Company, a Corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Ohio and authorized to do an indemnifying business in the state of Toxas, and whose principal office is located at (name/address/phone) 6200 S.
