EXITING ELECTED OFFICIAL EXPENDITURE ORDER PER SECTION 130.908 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE FOR THE REMAINDER TO THE 2022 CALENDAR YEAR

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code Section 130.908 requires a commissioners court to approve any expenditure of an elected county or precinct officer who was not re-nominated or re-elected ("Exiting Elected Official") that is over an amount set by the commissioners court; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Exiting Elected Official Expenditure Order ("Order") is to establish expenditure limits that require approval of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court ("Court").

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- When a Fort Bend County Elected County or Precinct Official is not re-nominated or reelected, during the time following the date of the announcement of the results of the official canvass of the November 8, 2022 General and Special Election, expenditures that exceed \$5,000 shall require advance approval by the Court before Fort Bend County is obligated to pay the expenditure.
- 2. This Order shall be applicable to all expenditures by the Exiting Elected Official, except those expenditures made exclusively from funds that, by statute, are not under the control of the Court.
- 3. This Order shall not be applicable to any personnel and/or salary matters, which shall remain subject to established Fort Bend County policies.
- 4. This Order is effective as of the date signed.
