The list of companies, Hegar said, "repre-sents our initial effort to shine a light on entities that are engag-ing in these practices and create some clarity for Texans whose tax dollars may be working to directly undermine our state's economic health."

Last Wednesday, Hegar an-

nounced his list of financial companies that boycott energy companies. Listed companies are subject to the divestment provisions outlined in Texas Government Code Chapter 809, which defines a financial company as a publicly traded financial services, banking or investment company. The publication of the list, maintained by the Comptroller's office, follows an exhaustive period of research and process development.

The initial list includes 10 financial companies. Comptrol-ler staff researched individual investment funds, generating a list of nearly 350 funds that are subject to the same provisions as the companies.

"The tack of transparency

"We will continue to refine this process and gather additional information about how these firms may be boycotting energy companies.
