SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER SUPPLEMENTING AND CLARIFYING  
TOLL VIOLATION ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

(“Order”) was duly introduced for the consideration of the Commissioners Court and reviewed in full. It was then duly moved by Commissioner Meyers and seconded by Commissioner Prestage that the Order be passed; and, after due discussion, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Order, prevailed and carried by the following vote:

The County Judge thereupon announced that the Order has been duly and lawfully adopted. The Order thus adopted follows:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER SUPPLEMENTING AND CLARIFYING TOLL  
VIOLATION ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

BACKGROUND

The Fort Bend County Toll Road Authority (“Authority”) is operating the Fort Bend Parkway and Westpark Tollway Toll Roads on behalf of Fort Bend County (“County”); and

The Authority desires to supplement and clarify policies and procedures relating to toll violation enforcement on the Fort Bend Parkway and Westpark Tollway, by expressly including reference to language in Section 284.070 of the Transportation Code allowing the County to take and retain possession of a vehicle until the amount of unpaid tolls and related charges are paid;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

The *Amended and Restated Order Establishing a Toll Rate Schedule for the Fort Bend County Toll Road System; Prohibiting the Operation of a Motor Vehicle on the Road System After Failure to Pay Required Toll or Charge; Establishing an Administrative Adjudication Hearing Procedure for Violation of this Order; Containing Other Provisions Relating to the Subject* dated April 6, 2021, and the *Supplemental Order Establishing a Toll Rate Schedule for the Fort Bend Parkway and Westpark Tollway* dated January 11, 2022, are hereby supplemented by replacing the first paragraph of Section 7 with the following:

*Section 7. Administrative Adjudication Procedure/ Administrative Hearing Process.*

**Appointment of Hearing Officers.** The Commissioners Court shall appoint one or more licensed attorneys to serve as hearing officers. A hearing officer appointed by Commissioners Court shall serve at the pleasure of the Commissioners Court and shall implement this administrative adjudication procedure. A hearing officer shall be paid up to seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) for each docket of hearing proceedings adjudicated.


3. That a true and complete copy of the Order (“Order”), as adopted at the meeting described in such excerpt from the minutes, is attached to and follows such excerpt.


