
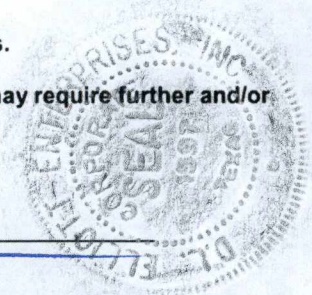

**1. SET POSTS AT REQUIRED SPACING**

**2. EXCAVATE A 6" x 12" TRENCH UPSTREAM**  
ALONG THE LINE OF POSTS AND SECURE MESH FENCE TO POSTS.

**3. ATTACH FILTER FABRIC TO POSTS**  
AND EXTEND IT INTO THE DOWNSTREAM BASIN, AND CONNECT THE EXCAVATED DOWNSIDE.

**REINFORCED FILTER FABRIC BARRIER**

**GENERAL NOTES:**

1. SECURELY FASTEN MESH FENCING TO POSTS WITH STAPLES OR NAILS.
2. SECURELY FASTEN FILTER FABRIC TO MESH FENCING.
3. WHEN TWO SECTIONS OF FILTER FABRIC ADJOIN EACH OTHER, OVERLAP 8 INCHES AT A POST, FOLD TOGETHER, AND ATTACH TO A POST.
4. MESH FENCING DEPOSTS MUST BEAT REACHES ONE-TWO OF THE HEIGHT OF THE FENCE IN DEPTH.
5. SET FENCE MINIMUM 2' BEHIND CURB.

**ABOVE GROUND TEMP. VEHICLE & EQUIPMENT FUELING AREA WITH TANKS**

**GENERAL NOTES:**

1. THE SIZE OF TANK FOUNDATION AREA DEPENDS ON THE SIZE OF ABOVE GROUND STORAGE TANK AND DISPENSER ASSEMBLY.
2. PROVIDE A MINIMUM SLOPE OF 2% TOWARD THE CURB FOR FILL.
3. INSTALL IMPERMEABLE LINER AS PER MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATIONS.

**INLET PROTECTION BARRIER FOR STAGE I INLETS**

**GENERAL NOTES:**

1. FIBER POLLS WILL BE UTILIZED ONLY WHEN SITE CONDITIONS DO NOT PERMIT THE USE OF FIBER FABRIC BARRIER, AND AS APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.

**STABILIZED CONSTRUCTION ACCESS**

**GENERAL NOTES:**

1. MINIMUM LENGTH IS AS SHOWN ON CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS OR 30 FEET, WHICHEVER IS LONGER.
2. STABILIZED ACCESS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED ONLY WITH CONCRETE OR WITH GEOTEXTILE WITH STABILIZED ACCESS.
3. UNLESS SHOWN ON THE CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS, STABILIZATION FOR OTHER AREAS WILL HAVE THE SAME AGGREGATE THICKNESS AND WIDTH REQUIREMENTS AS THE STABILIZED CONSTRUCTION PATH.
4. WHEN SHOWING ON THE CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS, WHEN OR LENGTHEN STABILIZED AREA TO ACCOMMODATE A TRUCK WASHOUT AREA, PROVIDE OUTLET (SLOPE) TOWARD THE TRUCK WASHOUT AREA.
5. PROVIDE PERIODIC TOP DRESSING WITH ADDITIONAL CONCRETE AGGREGATE TO MAINTAIN THE REQUIRED DEPTH OR WHEN SURFACE BECOMES PAVED WITH ROAD.
6. PERIODICALLY TURN AGGREGATE TO EXPOSE A CLEAN DRIVING SURFACE.
7. MINIMUM 14" WIDTH FOR ONE WAY TRAFFIC AND 20" WIDTH FOR TWO WAY TRAFFIC.

**BARREL STORAGE AREA**

**GENERAL NOTES:**

1. ALTERNATIVELY, STORAGE BARRELS IN AN ENCLOSED BUILDING OR SHED.
2. INSTALL IMPERMEABLE LINER AS PER MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATIONS. NO MIN. BARRELS.
3. CONSTRUCT BEHIND AREA WITH VOLUME GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO FIVE VOLUMES OF BARRELS.

**INLET PROTECTION BARRIERS FOR STAGE II INLETS**

**GENERAL NOTES:**

1. REMOVE SEGMENT DEPOSITS WITHIN THE SEGMENT OF THE BARRIER.
2. CHANNEL BARS SHALL NOT EXCEED DIMENSIONS OF INLET UNLESS CHARTERED BY ENGINEER.

**CONCRETE TRUCK WASHOUT AREA**

**GENERAL NOTES:**

1. POST A SIGN READING "CONCRETE WASHOUT PIT" NEXT TO THE PIT.
2. VEHICULARLY INSPECT THE CONCRETE TRUCK DRIVERS WHERE THE PIT IS AND TO WASHOUT THEIR TRUCKS IN THE PIT AND NORMALLY ELSE.
3. UPON THE CONCRETE SETTING UP (CLOSING) OPENING OUT, THE CONCRETE BARS SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE PROJECT SITE AND DEPOSITED OF PROPERLY BY THE CONTRACTOR AFTER REMOVAL OF THE CONCRETE BARS, THE WASHOUT PIT SHALL BE FILLED WITH CLEAN FILL MATERIAL, AND COMPLETED TO USUALLY CONDITIONS, OR AS DIRECTED BY THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS.
4. CONCRETE WASHOUT PITS SHALL NOT BE LOCATED DIRECTLY ADJACENT TO HIGHWAY AT ANY TIME DURING THE STORM SEASON STOPS ON ANY OTHER STREET, DITCH OR WATERWAY.
5. CONSTRUCT ENTRY ROAD AND BOTTOM OF WASHOUT AREA TO SUPPORT EXPECTED LOADINGS FROM TRUCKS EQUIPMENT.
