
# Proclamation





- WHEREAS,** a graduate of the University of West George, Mary was elected the first female Mayor of Mount Zion, a city in Carroll County, Georgia; and
- WHEREAS,** following relocating to Texas in 1977, where her education and training includes the Texas Judicial Training for Justices of the Peace, Municipal Judge Training, Texas Department of Criminal Justice Law Enforcement Training, A&M Law Enforcement Training; and
- WHEREAS,** Mary served the citizens of Fort Bend County in various offices including being one of the first female detectives in Fort Bend County, as a lieutenant with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, being appointed by former Governor Ann Richards to open the first drug and alcohol rehabilitation facility in the prison system in the state of Texas, and serving as Fort Bend County Precinct 1, Place 2 Justice of the Peace for three terms; and
- WHEREAS,** Mary has served as an active member of the VFW Post 3903 Auxiliary, a life member of the Fort Bend County Fair Association, the Rosenberg Lions Club, and many other areas in the community; and




