## FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE COLLECTION OF TAXES

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between the County of Fort Bend, Texas, with the agreement, consent, and participation of the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor/Collector (singularly or collectively referred to as "County" or "County Tax Assessor/Collector"), and City of Kendleton, a taxing entity in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE COLLECTION OF TAXES in January 2022 (hereinafter "Agreement") pursuant to Section 6.24 of the Texas Property Tax Code and the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791, Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to reflect the change in Services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation under the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the parties do mutually agree as follows:

## Sec 3.09 shall be revised to update collection frequency as follows:

3.09 The taxes collected by County shall be remitted to City of Kendleton at least once a week.

## Sec 4.02 Shall be revised to reflect additional costs as follows:

- 4.02 For services rendered pursuant to this Agreement, City of Kendleton agrees to pay County for the actual costs incurred, for assessing or collecting taxes for City of Kendleton in accordance with Tax Code Section 6.27. The Parties acknowledge and agree that these amounts as of the date of this Execution are as follows:
  - A. Forty cents (\$0.40) per parcel per year;
  - B. One dollar (\$1.00) per account to add delinquent accounts to County's
  - C. Two dollars and seventy-seven cents (\$2.77) per account outside of Fort Bend County; and

D. Costs for which City of Kendleton will reimburse the County for actual costs incurred for any additional services requested by City of Kendleton or mandated by state statute.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged. In the event of conflict, this First Amendment shall prevail over the executed Interlocal.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have signed or have caused their respective names to be signed to multiple counterparts to be effective on the date signed by the final party.
