WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas ("Commissioners Court"), has heretofore appointed Joseph Sheets, Charles Gregory Baker, and Dan Noltensmeyer to the Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 20 (the "District") to serve for lawful four-year terms of office through August 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court desires to reappoint Joseph Sheets, Charles Gregory Baker, and Dan Noltensmeyer to serve as Directors for the District for lawful four-year terms of office commencing effective August 28, 2023, and expiring on August 28, 2027, or until their successors shall be appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Sheets is over twenty-one years of age, a resident citizen of the State of Texas, otherwise qualified by law to serve as a Director of the District, and not disqualified from serving as a Director of the District by reason of any law; and

WHEREAS, Charles Gregory Baker is over twenty-one years of age, a resident citizen of the State of Texas, otherwise qualified by law to serve as a Director of the District, and not disqualified from serving as a Director of the District by reason of any law; and

WHEREAS, Dan Noltensmeyer is over twenty-one years of age, a resident citizen of the State of Texas, otherwise qualified by law to serve as a Director of the District, and not disqualified from serving as a Director of the District by reason of any law; and; and

WHEREAS, Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, confers jurisdiction on the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas to appoint the Directors of the District; Now Therefore,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE AND COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct.
