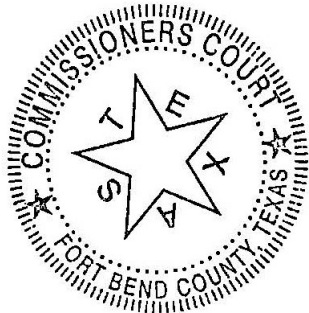
Item 3 continued - Canvass Votes

John Oldham, Elections Administrator explained the canvassing began the Friday before Thanksgiving and concluded this past Friday. Over 360,000 ballots were retabulated through central scanners and ended with eight fewer ballots being tabulated than in the original election; this will become the official result for the Sheriff's race. The winning margin went from 985 votes to 986 votes. Sheriff Fagan gained one vote in this process.
