**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER
CALLING AN ELECTION TO CONFIRM THE CREATION OF FORT BEND COUNTY
EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10, IN PRECINCT 2 AND AUTHORIZE THE
IMPOSITION OF A TAX NOT TO EXCEED THE RATE
ALLOWED BY SECTION 48-E, ARTICLE III, TEXAS CONSTITUTION**

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court received PETITION FOR AN EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT SEEKING TO CREATE FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10, IN PRECINCT 2 [the "Petition"];

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court made the requisite findings and conducted a public hearing on the Petition on January 23, 2024 to grant the Petition as authorized by Texas Health and Safety Code Sec. 775.017;

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court granted the Petition by executing a RESOLUTION APPROVING PETITION FOR AN EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT SEEKING TO CREATE FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10, IN PRECINCT 2,

IT IS THEREFORE **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS that:

1. An election will be held, pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code Sec. 775.018, on the next uniform election date under Chapter 41, Texas Election Code, to confirm the creation of FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10, IN PRECINCT 2, in the boundaries of the proposed Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A", and to authorize the imposition of a tax authorized by Texas Health and Safety Code Sec. 775.018;
2. The election shall be on the 4th day of May, 2024, which date is the next uniform

election date under Chapter 41, Texas Election Code;

3. The creation of the district at the election shall be by majority vote of all the voters; except that the district may not include territory in a municipality's limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction unless a majority of the voters residing in that territory who vote at the election vote in favor of creating the district;
4. At the election, the below proposition shall be submitted to the qualified voters who reside in the proposed District:

CONFIRMATION OF THE CREATION OF FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10 AND THE LEVY BY SAID DISTRICT OF A TAX NOT TO EXCEED TEN (10) CENTS ON THE ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$100.00) VALUATION.

5. The ballot of the election shall conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and shall have printed thereon the following:

Confirmation of the creation of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 and the levy by the District of a tax not to exceed ten (10) cents on the one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation.

6. The ballots for the election shall provide for voting "for" or "against" the proposition. A vote "for" shall mean a vote in favor of the proposition, and a vote "against" shall mean a vote opposing the proposition.

7. A majority of the total votes cast "for" or "against" the proposition creating Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 shall determine if Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 is approved. Provided, however, if so approved, the proposed Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 may not include territory in the Village of Fairchilds corporate and municipal limits and the Village of Fairchilds extraterritorial jurisdiction unless a majority of the voters residing in the Village of Fairchilds corporate and municipal limits and the Village of Fairchilds extraterritorial jurisdiction who vote at the election vote in favor of creating Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10.

8. Election Procedures:

The election on the proposition to create Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 shall be held in the area of the boundaries of the proposed Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 on the 4th day of May, 2024 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

A. The election shall be conducted such that the voters in the area of the boundaries of the proposed Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 shall vote on the proposition as a whole to determine the passage of the proposition, provided, however, that (i) the ballots voted by the voters in the Village of Fairchilds corporate and municipal limits, and (ii) the ballots voted by the voters in the Village of Fairchilds extraterritorial jurisdiction shall be counted, tabulated and reported separately.

The creation of the proposed Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 shall be determined as follows:

the creation of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 shall require a majority vote at the election in favor of the proposition, counted, tabulated and reported as a whole;

if a majority of the votes cast at the election as a whole vote are in favor of the proposition, then inclusion of the Village of Fairchilds corporate and municipal limits and the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Village of Fairchilds in the proposed Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 10 shall require approval of the proposition by the voters in the combined area of the Village of Fairchilds corporate and municipal limits and its extraterritorial jurisdiction, which votes shall also be counted, tabulated and reported separately.

B. The Notice of the Election shall be given and the election shall be held in compliance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code in all respects, and, as applicable, Texas Health and Safety Code, including Section 775.018. The ballots for the election shall comply with this Order, the Texas Election Code and, as applicable, Texas Health and Safety Code, and shall be in the form as determined by the Fort Bend County Election Administrator for use on the voting devices and ballots used by Fort Bend County.

(i) the Notice of the Election shall be given in the same manner as the notice of the petition hearing,

(ii) the Fort Bend County Clerk or Elections Administrator shall give notice of the election in the manner prescribed in Texas Health and Safety Code Sec. 775.015(c), and not later than the 21st day before the date on which the election will be held, the Notice of Election shall be posted at the courthouse door and shall be published in the *Fort Bend Herald* once a week for two consecutive weeks. The first publication shall occur not later than the 21st day before the date on which the election will be held.

C. **John Oldham**, the Fort Bend County Election Administrator is hereby confirmed and appointed to serve as the Election Officer and Early Voting Clerk. The Fort Bend County Election Administrator's employees and appointees, along with the election judges, alternate election judges and election clerks appointed by the Fort Bend County Election Officer are likewise designated and shall hold and conduct this election in the manner provided under the Texas Election Code and,

as applicable, the Texas Health and Safety Code, including Sections 775.018 and 775.019 (regarding voting in the territory in the Village of Fairchilds corporate and municipal limits and extraterritorial jurisdiction).

D. The main early voting polling place for this election shall be located at: Rosenberg Annex Building, 4520 Reading Rd., Rosenberg, TX 77471

Early voting by personal appearance at the main early voting polling place shall be conducted on the days of the early voting period and during the hours that the Fort Bend County Election Administrator's main business office is regularly open for business.

All ballots, voting instructions, signs, posters and other election materials required by Texas Election Code, shall be prepared in English and Spanish, and shall contain such provisions, instructions, markings and verbiage as required by law.

E. The election precincts for the election shall be those precincts established by Fort Bend County, and administered by the Fort Bend County Election Administrator; provided, however, that (i) the ballots voted by the voters in Village of Fairchilds corporate and municipal limits shall be counted, tabulated and reported separately, and, (ii) the ballots voted by the voters in the Village of Fairchilds extraterritorial jurisdiction shall be counted, tabulated and reported separately.

F. Polling Places shall be those voting locations approved as provided in this and any other election orders made by Fort Bend County Commissioner's Court and/or the County Election Administrator. (See Exhibit "B", attached to this Order, subject to change.)

G. Early Voting by personal appearance and by mail will be conducted and coordinated by the Fort Bend County Election Administrator, who is also hereby designated as the Early Voting Clerk for this election. Early Voting by personal appearance shall be held at those places so selected and designated by the County Election Administrator. Early voting shall commence on April 22, 2024 and shall continue through April 30, 2024. Election day and early voting locations shall be as established by County Election Administrator and are subject to change. (See Exhibit "C", attached to this Order, subject to change.)

John Oldham, County Election Administrator, is hereby appointed to serve as the custodian of election records, and recorder for this election. The County Election Administrator will also serve as the Regular Early Voting Clerk to receive requests for applications for early voting ballots.

Applications for voting by mail for all voters in the election must be submitted by personal/commercial delivery no later than April 23, 2024, and ballots voted by mail must be received by Saturday, May 4, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. if carrier envelope is not postmarked, or Monday, May 6, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. if carrier envelope is postmarked by 7:00 p.m. on May 4, 2024, at the location of the election on Election Day (unless overseas or military voter deadlines apply).

Applications for voting by mail shall be sent by US Postal Mail or personal/commercial delivery, or, as permitted by law, telefax, or email.

H. As soon as practicable, after the election the election officials holding same shall make and deliver the returns and the results thereof to the Fort Bend County Commissioner's Court for the Commissioner's Court to canvass the returns and declare the results of the election.

9. At such meeting of properly called by Fort Bend County Commissioner's Court following its receipt of the election returns and the results thereof, Fort Bend County Commissioner's Court shall consider and enter an order pursuant to the applicable provisions of Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 775.019 regarding this election.

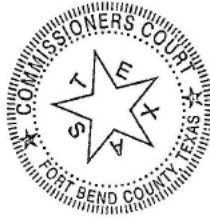

Beginning at a point on the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6 (Pleak area Emergency Services District) along the east Right-of-Way of FM 2977 at the intersection with the midline of Big Creek;

Thence, in a northeasterly direction along the midline of Big Creek and all its meanders to its intersection with the northwesterly line of a 312.00 acre parcel of land identified as Fort Bend County Central Appraisal District Property Geographic ID No. 0095-00-000-6210-906 (and Reference ID No. R40413);

Thence, in a southwesterly direction along the northwesterly property line of said 312.00 acre parcel of land to the centerline of Psencik Road;

Thence, in a southeasterly direction along the centerline of Psencik Road to the projected southeasterly property line of a 100.00 acre parcel of land identified as Fort Bend County Central Appraisal District Property Geographic ID No. 0095-00-000-6510-906 (and Reference ID No. R40414);

Thence, in a northeasterly direction along the southeasterly property line of said 100.00 acre parcel of land to its intersection with the midline of Big Creek;

Thence, in a northeasterly direction along the midline of Big Creek and all its meanders to its intersection with the centerline of Boothline Road;

Thence, in a northeasterly direction along the centerline of Boothline Road to its intersection with the centerline of Ricefield Road;

Thence, in a southeasterly direction along the centerline of Ricefield Road to its intersection with the centerline of FM 762;

Thence, in a southeasterly direction along the centerline of FM 762 to an angle point in said road;

Thence, in a southwesterly direction along the centerline of FM 762 to an angle point in said road;

Thence, in a southeasterly direction along the centerline of FM 762 to its intersection with the midline of Big Creek;

Thence, in a northeasterly, easterly, and southeasterly direction following the midline of Big Creek and all its meanders to its intersection with the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and the north Right-of-Way of Sawmill Road);

Thence, in a westerly direction along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and north Right-of-Way of Sawmill Road) to its intersection with the west Right-of-Way of FM 762;

Thence, in a southerly direction continuing along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and west Right-of-Way of FM 762) to its intersection with the north Right-of-Way of Davis Estates Road;

Thence, in a westerly, southerly, and northwesterly direction continuing along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and northerly and westerly Right-of-Way of Davis Estates Road) to its intersection with the northwesterly Right-of-Way of FM 1994;

Thence, in a southwesterly direction continuing along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and northwesterly Right-of-Way of FM 1994) to its intersection with northeasterly Right-of-Way of Zamanek Road;

Thence, in a northwesterly direction continuing along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and northeasterly Right-of-Way line of Zamanek Road) to its intersection with the northwesterly Right-of-Way line of Roesler Road;

Thence, in a southwesterly direction continuing along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and northwesterly Right-of-Way of Roesler Road) to its intersection with the northeasterly Right-of-Way of Jeske Road;

Thence, in a northwesterly direction continuing along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and northeasterly Right-of-Way of Jeske Road) to its intersection with the southeasterly Right-of-Way of State Highway 36;

Thence, in a northeasterly direction continuing along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (and southeasterly Right-of-Way of State Highway 36) to its intersection with the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6 (and southeasterly Right-of-Way of Williams School Road);

Thence, in a northeasterly direction along the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6 (and southeasterly Right-of-Way of Williams School Road) to an angle point in the jurisdictional boundary line of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6;
