**RENEWAL AND EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT FOR FFP FUNDING
 BETWEEN JUSTICE BENEFITS, INC. AND FORT BEND COUNTY**

This Renewal and Extension Agreement (“Renewal”) is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County, (hereinafter “County”), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and Justice Benefits, Inc. as the general partner of JBI, LTD., a Texas limited partnership (hereinafter referred to as “JBI” or “Contractor”), located at 1711 E. Belt Line Road, Coppell, Texas 75019.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the parties have executed and accepted that certain *Agreement For FFP Funding Between Justice Benefits, Inc. And Fort Bend County* (the “Agreement,”) on or about June 23, 2020, as renewed by document executed on August 3, 2021, August 32, 2022 and June 27, 2023; and

WHEREAS, JBI is assisting the County to obtain reimbursements through Federal Financial Participation (hereinafter “FFP”); and

WHEREAS, County desires to renew the Agreement for an additional year, so JBI will continue to provide professional assistance to County exploring opportunities for FFP, reviewing prospects for expansion of existing FFP, and securing FFP for County; and

WHEREAS, the following changes are incorporated as if a part of the original Agreement by reference in the same as if fully set forth verbatim therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

RENEWAL AND EXTENSION

1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Agreement.
2. **Time of Performance.** The Agreement is hereby renewed for an additional one year period effective June 23, 2024, and will terminate on June 22, 2025.
3. **Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts.** The contents of this Section are required by Texas Law and are included by County regardless of content. For purposes of Sections 2252.152, 2271.002, and 2274.002, Texas Government Code, as amended,

Contractor hereby verifies that Contractor and any parent company, wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, and affiliate:

- a. Unless affirmatively declared by the United States government to be excluded from its federal sanctions regime relating to Sudan or Iran or any federal sanctions regime relating to a foreign terrorist organization, is not identified on a list prepared and maintained by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Section 806.051, 807.051, or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.
- b. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not boycott Israel and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott Israel during the term of such contracts. "Boycott Israel" has the meaning provided in § 808.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- c. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not boycott energy companies and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott energy companies during the term of such contracts. "Boycott energy company" has the meaning provided in § 809.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- d. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the term of such contracts. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association" has the meaning provided in § 2274.001(3) of the Texas Government Code. "Firearm entity" and "firearm trade association" have the meanings provided in § 2274.001(6) and (7) of the Texas Government Code.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement, including any addenda or amendments, not modified herein shall remain in full force and effect for the term of Agreement. If there is a conflict between this Renewal and the Agreement for FFP Funding Between Justice Benefits, Inc. and Fort Bend County, the provisions of this Renewal shall prevail with regard to the conflict.

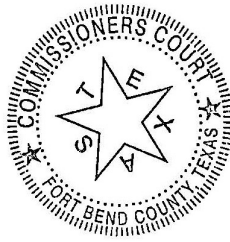
